
Make a difference in the education of MUHS Students

A.R.S. 43-1089 was enacted by the Legislature to give Arizona taxpayers the opportunity to support a student, a group of students, or an extracurricular program that meets the following requirements

- 1. "Character education programs" a program described in section 15-719. Under this statute (ARS § 15-719) each district may develop it's own course of study for each grade. At a minimum, the character education program must include instruction in the definition and application of at least six of the following character traits: truthfulness, responsibility, compassion, diligence, sincerity, trustworthiness, respect, attentiveness, obedience, orderliness, forgiveness and virtue.
- 2. "Extracurricular activities" means school sponsored activities that require enrolled students to pay a fee in order to participate including fees for:
 - (a) Band uniforms.
 - (b) Equipment or uniforms for varsity athletic activities.

A tax credit receipt will be mailed to you

- (c) Scientific laboratory materials.
- (d) In-state or out-of-state trips that are solely for competitive events. Extracurricular activities do not include any senior trips or events that are recreational, amusement or tourist activities.
